Tithes and offerings

Our church functions on the generosity and faithfulness of our members to return their tithes and offerings. Whilst our buildings may be closed, there are still ongoing costs and we'd like to encourage you to continue to faithfully return what's the Lords.

As we're not meting physically, we'll provide a number of online options for each church. If you do not have access to the internet or are not comfortable with making electronic payments, the best option is to put your tithes and offerings aside in a safe place until the church re-opens.

Tithes

There are a number of methods to pay your **TITHE ONLY**. **DO NOT PAY LOCAL OFFERING THROUGH THESE METHODS**.

- 1. Bank transfer directly to the NEC
 - Natwest Bank Plc
 - Account number: 84598816
 - Sort code: 60-80-09
 - Reference: Your name and also your gift aid number

2. Pay online through the website

Follow the link to the NEC website - https://nec.adventist.uk/contact-us/donate/

If you follow the link above, you can return tithes if you select, "Tithe by Churches" from the Purpose list, or you can donate to various mission offerings further down the list. When returning tithes, please select your church from the list.

If you have a gift aid number, you can select the Gift Aid option and then enter your Gift Aid number. Please note that your full Gift Aid number is "2049" followed by the 4 digits that you are familiar with and you'll need to enter the full Gift Aid number. For example, if you know your Gift Aid number as "1234", then enter "20491234" on the web page.

After you click the "Donate" button, you'll be shown a summary of what you're paying at which point you can either click "Change" or "PayPal Check Out". You don't need to have a PayPal account (you can pay by debit/credit card), although it will insist on creating a PayPal account for you at the same time.

If you want to return Tithes AND Offerings, then you'll need to go through the above process for each separately.

3. Over the phone

During this challenging time, all donations for **LOCAL OFFERINGS ONLY**. Please DO NOT pay tithes or mission offerings a local church bank account - that is for LOCAL offerings only.

1. Bank transfer to the local church

Include you the following information in the "Reference" section: Initial, surname, amount and purpose.

For the purpose, including the following letters:

- O Local church offering
- B Church building fund
- G Good Samaritan/Dorcus Fund

Example:

If John Smith wants to pay £100 into the church account, it would show as "J Smith O40 B60"

If there are not enough characters to add all the information, just put your name on the reference and then text the treasury team with more information.

You will be provided with a receipt.
